4. I have three times as many dimes as nickels. The total amount I have in dimes and nickels is \$3.50. How many of each coin do I have?
5. I bought 12 reams of paper and 8 boxes of writing tablets for \$236. I later bought 9 reams of paper and 10 boxes of writing tablets for \$205. Find the prices for one ream of paper and one box of writing tablets.
